



2004 “EASTSIDE” SHIRAZ

Colour: Deep red

Aroma: Brooding, concentrated aromas of super-ripe Shiraz with dark chocolate/mocha notes to the fore with underlying ripe plums, prune and blackberry.

Palate: The palate is soft, rich and full flavoured with some nice charry oak evident that is in harmony with the natural tannins, acid and sweet, ripe fruit.

Summary: Drink over the next 3-6 years. Should match beef wellington almost perfectly.

TECHNICAL NOTES:

14.5% Alc/Vol, 3.60pH, 6.25 g/L TA, 2.3 g/L RS.

100% Clare Valley fruit. Aged for 18 months in new and older French oak barriques.
