



## 2012 “The Dogwalk” Cabernet Merlot

Appearance: Medium to deep red.

Aroma: Perfumed aromas of blackcurrant, dark cherry with a just a touch of crushed violets. The subtle/cedary French oak is very much in the background as it should be.

Palate: A medium bodied palate displaying excellent concentration of dark fruits, fine tannins, balanced acidity and barely perceptible oak.

Summary: From an excellent vintage and quite possibly the best Dogwalk we have released. Makes a really nice drink now for such a young wine, but it will take 3-5 years cellaring easily. Try this wine with a hard cheese such as Pecorino.
