



## 2010 “TRADITIONALE” RIESLING

### TASTING NOTES:

Colour: Brilliant, medium / pale green.

Aroma: Spotlessly clean and quite expressive, displaying citrus florals, apple and subtle notes of stone fruits and slate.

Palate: Crisp, fresh and dry, loaded with “waxy” lemon and grapefruit flavours wrapped around a core of well balanced mineral acidity.

Summary: Another really good Pikes Riesling from what was quite a challenging vintage. Makes a lovely drink as a fresh, young white wine, but will take 5-7 years in the bottle for those who like bottle aged Riesling.

### TECHNICAL NOTES:

Analysis: 12.3% Alc, 3.05 pH, 7.77 g/L TA, 4.6 g/L RS, 40/135 mg/L SO<sub>2</sub>.

Closure: Screwcap
