



2011 “IMPOSTORES” SAVIGNAN

TASTING NOTES:

Colour: Brilliant, pale green.

Aroma: Subtle aromas of mineral, white pepper & celery plus some tropical fruits in the background.

Palate: A medium weight palate of white pepper and mineral that finishes crisp, fresh and pleasantly dry. Also just a touch of “salty/briney” mineral character.

Summary: Our second attempt at a wine made from the Savignan grape and a significant step up from the 2010. It makes a nice alternative to other mainstream dry whites. Drink over the next 2 summers.

Analysis: 11.0% Alc, 2.92 pH, 7.37 g/L TA, 4.5 g/L RS

Estate Grown single vineyard wine.
